### Returning Library Books

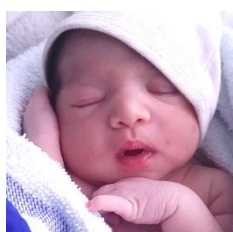
The end of the school Summer term is fast approaching. The library needs to have all library books returned before students break up for the summer holidays. Students need to make sure and check if they have a library book to return.
