Tuition Fund statement

The Education and Skills Funding Agency 16 to 19 tuition fund has been allocated to schools and colleges in 2021/22 to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19).

The funding is being provided to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths and other courses where learning has been disrupted as a result of the pandemic. All supported students must be on a 16 to 19 study programme.

The school will provide support as follows:

• Additional 1:1 academic and wellbeing support via sixth form study supervisors

• Additional small group catch-up tutorials in A level subjects

• Additional small group catch-up tutorials in vocational subjects

• Additional online support and resources to extend learning outside of the classroom

Each session will contain a maximum of five students to ensure that each student receives the intensive catch up support they require to make up for the disruption to their learning and prepare them for the successful completion of their study programme.
