It is our ongoing mission to educate our young people about the benefits and risks of living in a digital age. In a time of social networking particularly, it's vital that students know how to keep themselves safe online.

This could allow strangers to access identifying information that may put students at risk, such as which school they go to and even where they live.

Please be vigilant of what your son or daughter is posting online and have regular open conversations with them about safe and appropriate mobile phone and social media use.
