

Exam conditions

1. Know the dates, arrival, and finish times of all of your exams



2. Know exactly what equipment you need.



3. Arrive outside the hall (or your planned exam space) 15 minutes before the start of your exam.

4. Before you enter the hall, make sure you have eaten and been to the toilet. You will not be allowed to leave the hall before the end of the exam unless you have a medical reason.



5. Enter the hall in silence, find your desk, sit down facing the front. Do not communicate with any other student, verbally or non-verbally, inside the hall.



6. Be prepared to work for the full duration of your exam. When you have finished, use the time to check your answers. Do not allow yourself to turn around or be distracted in anyway.



7. Do not graffiti your desk, name card, or doodle in your exam papers.



8. Do not put your head on the desk at any point.



9. Ensure that your phone is switched off and left outside of the exam hall in your bag. Headphones and watches are also not permitted.



10. Finally, remember to give every single question a chance, writing something is better than nothing! Have a go.
